## Message from Rev. Cannon

The Lord is risen. He is risen indeed! This week is Holy Week, where Christians all around the world will gather in houses of worship to celebrate our Risen King. Jesus died for us so that we might all have eternal life. He died for the rich and the poor, the educated and uneducated, those who despair and those who have joy, the wise and the foolish, the strong and the weak. He died for all.

But we must beware of the darkness that dwells within a man's heart, for it can block out the light that God is trying to instill. We must seek God in all things, while He can still be found. Seeking God allows us to focus upon Him and not upon ourselves, lest we begin to think too highly of ourselves. Reflect upon these words from 1 Corinthians 1:26-31.

<sup>26</sup>Consider your own call, brothers and sisters: not many of you were wise by human standards, not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth. <sup>27</sup>But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong; <sup>28</sup>God chose what is low and despised in the world, things that are not, to reduce to nothing things that are, <sup>29</sup>so that no one might boast in the presence of God. <sup>30</sup>He is the source of your life in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification and redemption, <sup>31</sup>in order that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord."

Our Risen Lord died that we may have everything. And in God, we do have everything. As long as God comes first, we have His peace, His love, His joy, His home, His...well, everything. Sarah Young author of *Jesus Calling* captures this thought:

In Me you have everything. In Me you are complete. Your capacity to experience Me is increasing through My removal of debris and clutter from your heart. As your yearning for Me increases, other desires are gradually lessening. Since I am infinite and abundantly accessible to you, desiring Me above all else is the best way to live. It is impossible for you to have a need that I cannot meet. After all, I created you and everything that is. The world is still at My beck and call, though it often appears otherwise. Do not be fooled by appearances. Things that are visible are brief and fleeting, while things that are invisible are everlasting.

Focus upon Jesus Christ and put your trust in the Risen Lord! He is our all in all and in Him we have all we ever need.
