The Soup Kitchen Needs YOU!

In 1977 FPC helped establish Christian Ministries here in Lincolnton. Our congregation has been involved in all aspects of this organization, from continuously collecting food and clothing, to working in the Soup Kitchen and special projects to serving on the Board of Directors.

Today we find our congregation much changed. We are older. There are less of us. In spite of that we continue to contribute goods and service to the work of Christian Ministries using the best of our individual talents.

Beginning in December the schedule will change. Instead of always serving the first Sunday of each month we will ALTERNATE SATURDAY's and SUNDAY's throughout the year. Now there is flexibility to serve on Saturday or Sunday and communion can be celebrated on the traditional first Sunday. This will allow our Pastor and our Music Director the freedom to cook and serve from time to time. It may also afford opportunities to involve our friends and neighbors in this Mission – people who are not willing to give up their Sunday worship.

October 18, 2016 Session Highlights

1. The Soup Kitchen dates for 2017 will change to include both Saturdays and Sundays. More details in the Mission section.
2. 'Regular' Communion - what used to be on the 2nd Sunday - has now moved to the 1st Sunday of the month. Special dates will still be observed. Effective immediately, we will have Communion on November 6th instead of November 13th.
3. We are finalizing carpet removal contractors and hope to have the job completed by 12/15/16. We expect to be out of the Sanctuary for 2 or 3 Sundays and will meet in the Fellowship Hall. The carpet removal and wood floor refinishing will include: all 3 vestibules; the entire Sanctuary; the pulpit area; and the administrative office.

The next Session meeting is Tuesday, November 15th, 6 pm in the Apple Classroom.
