As we enter into the Thanksgiving season let's remember there are millions without enough to eat. North Carolina allots \$4.06 per person per day for food. That includes ALL that you eat, drink, snacks and seasonings. Join us as we consciously live in these guidelines. Let's advocate for the less fortunate and live the biblical mandate of feeding all who are hungry!

There are many ways to join the challenge: Urge your Session and congregation to participate.

Screen the film, "A Place at the Table" (Netflix or Amazon) at your church. Contact your elected representatives and urge them to not cut the emergency food safety net.
