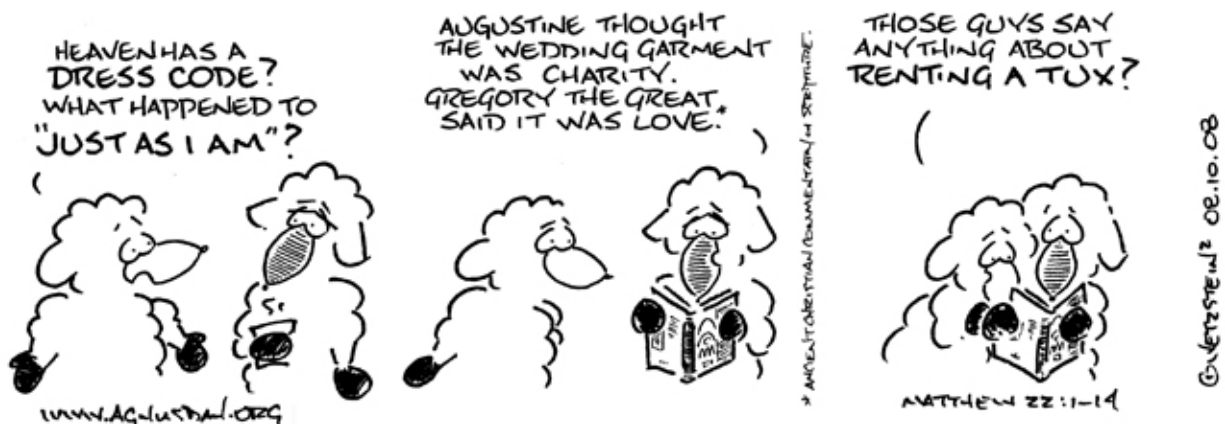

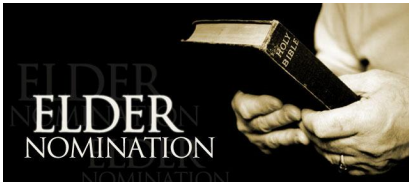


Music Ministry
