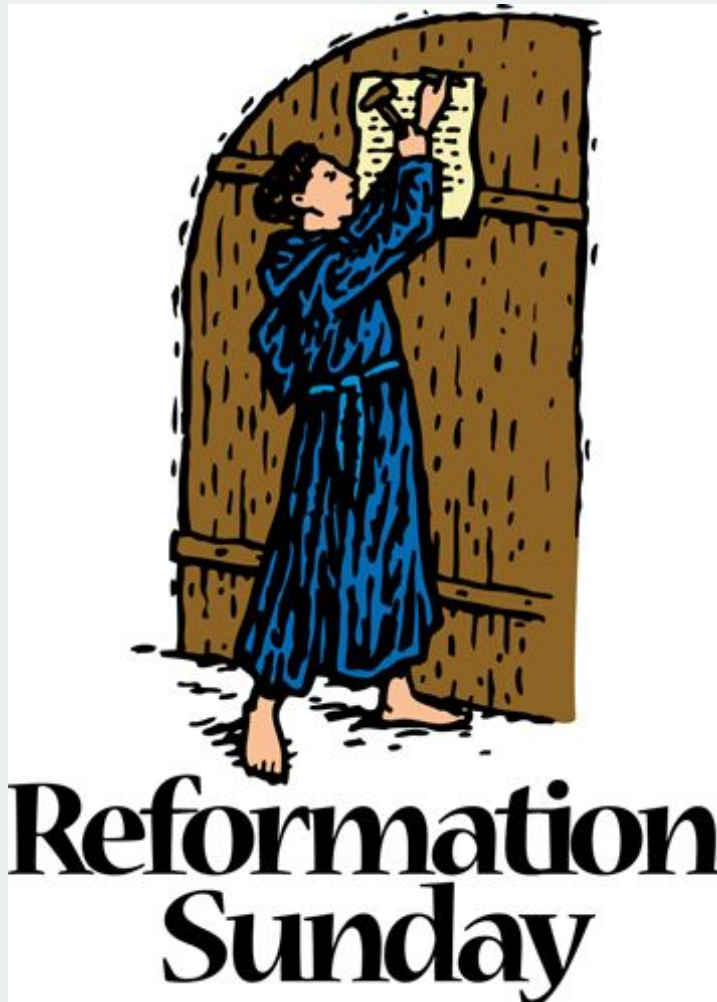

"By His Grace"

This week marks the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation. As depicted in the photo, German priest and monk Martin Luther penned 95 theological propositions for debate, now known as his famous "95 Theses." At noon on October 31, 1517, on the eve of All Saints' Day, when the sacred relics of Frederick the Elector would be on display and attract large crowds, Luther nailed his document to the door of the Castle Church in Wittenberg. Reformers outside of Germany soon followed Luther's lead including Jan Hus, Huldrych Zwingli and John Calvin - from whom Presbyterians trace their lineage.

At the heart of Luther's original petition was the Catholic Church's practice of selling indulgences; basically trading in the forgiveness of sin. From this uprising came the emphasis in the Protestant Church on God's grace, sanctification and justification. The idea that nothing we can say or do can separate us from the love of God or help to win God's favor.

This Sunday I will be turning to none other than the prolific Irish singer / songwriter Van Morrison to help explore the idea of being "saved by grace" and how our good works can be understood in the context of a Calvin born theology some 500 years later.

Join us for worship this Sunday at 10:30 AM where we will consider Luther, Calvin and how we might "try for the Kingdom" By His Grace.

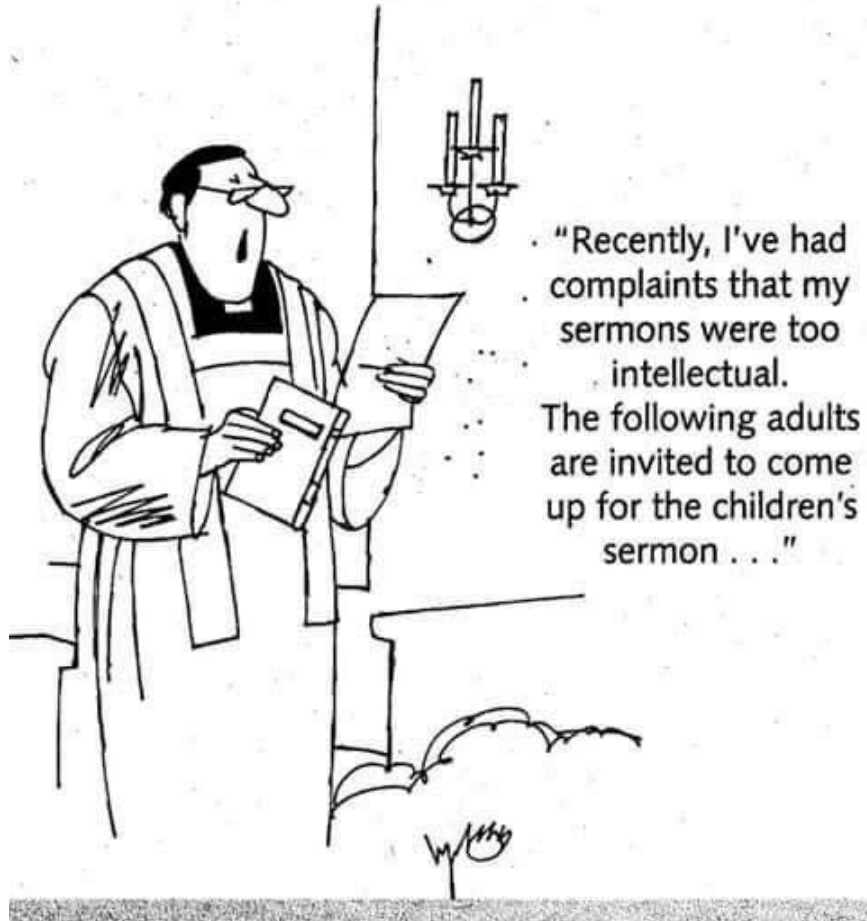
